Raising a Concern

Whilst we have a very friendly culture at Glenella SS, occasionally there may be times where your child may inform you of an incident/issue they have had with another student. If you have concerns regarding this alleged incident please report this to your child's teacher (generally first port of call) or Principal. Please adhere to/consider the following when raising a concern:

- ► Contact Teacher/Admin and calmly and respectfully register your concern.
- ► Maintain an OPEN MIND regarding the alleged incident. Appreciate that it is possible the teacher/admin are unaware of the incident and both you and they were not present during incident, hence an **investigation** needs to take place.
- ▶ Allow time for appropriate staff to conduct the investigation process.
- ► Under no circumstances are other parents/children to be approached or spoken to regarding the alleged incident.
- ▶ Please maintain confidentiality about the incident and do not discuss with other parents or post details of incident on social media.

► It is important to remember that we are **dealing with children who** are learning, and ALL discussions will focus on the alleged incident/actions not them as individuals.
