#### **ABSENCE TEXT LINE**

Please ensure you include your child's name, class and reason for absence.

#### **DELAY YOUR PICK-UP**

Did you know that there is no line up at Stop Drop & Go area from around 3.10pm. Students are supervised until 3.20pm, so if you can delay pick up by 10-15 minutes, you will not have to wait in the queue and traffic around the school will be greatly diminished. <u>CHECK</u> that your child has an <u>adequate healthy</u> lunch each day.




#### **MECC EXCURSION YRS 3-6**
